Jurying will look at quality, design, size, and overall appeal to our attendees—please see guidelines on next page. Quilts not chosen will be returned to the donor or if the donor wishes, placed in the Silent Auction.

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Live Auction Quilt Guidelines

1. Quilt needs to be a minimum of lap or throw size (twin, full, or queen sizes sell best).
2. Quilt must be free of stains, tears, etc. We understand that some quilts donated are historic or are not new. However, we will be unable to accept quilts that are damaged or show wear and tear.
3. The most popular quilts have a theme and are technically unique. People enjoy learning about the quilting style, design technique, etc. so please include that on your form.
4. You are welcome to use any fabric you wish, if there are special instructions for washing, please include those so that we can pass it on to the buyer.
5. Buyers like knowing the background of the quilt—why did you choose this design, why did this fabric stand out, is it made in memory of something or someone? Etc.
6. We will showcase the quilt in the auction to show off the backing material as well.
7. Quilt with full form is due with quilt by 5 pm, Friday, November 3, 2023 to be considered.
8. If accepted into the Live Auction, a full description will be required by 5 pm Friday, November 17th in order to be included in the program, tree sign, etc. After this date, we cannot guarantee the description can be included.
